NATION ARCHIVES CENSUS MICROFILM RENTAL: The National Archives have awarded a contract to a private company to operate the census microfilm rental program. This replaces the former inter-library loan of census film from the Archives which ceased 15 months ago. The program will begin operation the second week of July and will operate through participating public libraries. The fee will be \$2.25 per roll. The Bay City Branch Library on Center Avenue will be participating in this program.
