BAY COUNTY GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY VOLUME 12 NO 2 MARCH 1990

MEETING Our March meeting will be held at the Bay Co. South End Library on Tues. the 6th beginning at 6:30 p.m. Our program will be the final one in our series of information for persons starting a genealogical quest. There will be a presentation related to the use of land and Probate Court records followed by small group sessions intended to assist each other, and particularly folks who have started more recently in the development of a research plan. Our meetings this year have been well attended, and all of us have profitted by gaining new insights and/or reminders to abet our endeavors.

SOCIETY BUSINESS This will be the last issue of the Clarion for unpaid members. You might refer to the lower righthand corner of your membership card in order find your expiration date. A remittance of \$5.00 per person or \$7.00 per family is to be sent to our treasurer, Hilda Taylor, P.O. Box 27, Essexville, MI 48732. The society membership year begins 1 Jan. and ends 31 Dec. of the same year. Those who join in the fall have been considered paid until 31 Dec. of the next year.

The Pine Ridge Cemetery records and administration of that cemetery were discussed at the Jan. meeting. This is Bay City's oldest non-Catholic cemetery. Presently the administration of it is handled by a Mrs. Moore who lives in Bay City. Last year the Bay City Times reported that she feels some other individual or group needs to take over this project. She has been retired for many years, and reminds us that she is not getting "any younger." She has the records in very good shape, and answers all queries. Those records go back to the 1890s. Our discussion of this topic at our last meeting resulted in a number of questions relating to the storing of the records, basic administration and legal implications. Earl Lohrke has agreed to get us further information and have a report for the March meeting.

Duff Zube, who was unable to be with us, sent sample sheets that show what our Clerk's Records project will look like when completed. There will be an alphabetical listing of all deaths and marriages which were recorded in Bay Co. since ca 1860. We urge each of you who are able to consider spending some time filling out sheets at the Clerk's office. You may work there between 8:30 and 5:00 preferably Tue., Wed. & Thur. That office is very busy and crowded Mon. and Fri. Anyone needing information about the procedure may call Duff at 686-9449, Julie at 895- 5636, Lottie at 892-5563 or Bob at 895-8948. This promises to be a very rewarding project although one that will take a great deal of time. Please try to become involved. We need you!

We have received word from the National Genealogy Hall of Fame that the Michigan campaign to have Lucy Mary Kellogg named as a nominee to enter their Hall of Fame has met with success. Hers will be one of four names considered for that honor at the National Genealogy Society's Conference on 8 June this summer in Arlington, Virginia. Each year one person is inducted, and since over 25 organizations, some from out of state, supported her it appears that she is in a good position to be elected. However, if not she will automatically be on the ballot in 1991 unless her name is withdrawn.

Ruth Staudacher reported from the Mich. Genealogical Council meeting of January that our state has been invited to host the 1993 national seminar that summer. Our society and the others represented were asked to take formal action as to our interest in having the national in Michigan in '93 and if some of our group would assist in that activity. Following discussion we voted in the affirmative. The M.G.C. is expected to take final action on the issue in March.

JEWISH SYMBOLS- Gravestone symbols have the following meanings: a pitcher or jug= Levite, books or an open book= learned man or author, blessing hands= Kohen, ark with torah= rabbinic authority, menorah= female, star of David= male, lamb, broken tree trunk or bed= child (often found in another part of the cemetery), birds= soul, broken lilies= young child, broken candle= early death. Some animals stand for a name: dove= Jonah, bear= Dov, lion= Aryeh, Judah or Leo, fish=Fischel, eagle= Adler, rooster= Hahn. This information was reported to us by Ruth Staudacher.
