**** LOCAL HISTORY/GENEALOGY COLLECTION RULES AND REGULATIONS ****

In order for the Local History/Genealogy Collection to be maintained in the most effective and safe manner, the following rules and regulations have been adopted:

All patrons must sign in in the Registration Book at the main circulation desk before using the Collection.

Identification (driver's license, etc.) must be left at the circulation desk while using the Collection.

The Library's magazines in the storage area are to be handled by the Library Staff only. Browsing in this area is prohibited. Please ask at the circulation desk for help.

Materials in the Michigan Reference Collection do not circulate, but may be used in the library.

Much of the material in the Local History/Genealogy Collection is valuable and cannot be replaced. Please handle all materials with care.

Making photostatic copies may be restricted due to the condition of the materials. These restricted items will be designated with a marker stating that copies may not be made.

Only pencils may be used for writing while using the Collection. Please do not use ink.

Please leave used materials in the designated area to be reshelved by the Library Staff.
