Write to county clerks and enclose a SASE and ask them to send you a map of the Co. These are a big help in locating cemeteries, roads and landmarks. Write to, or visit older relatives and ask questions. You may be surprised at how eager they are to talk about "the good old days". Try to find a family Bible or old letters to give added clues.
