ELECTION OF OFFICERS FOR 1981 Election was held in December 1980 President Frances Cook Vice-Pres. Ruth Staudacher Recording Secy Esther Bernard Corr. Secy Inez Luce Treasurer Hilda Taylor Librarian Frances Cook The delegates to the Michigan Council will remain the same although we are not certain that the council will continue, due to the State austerity program. We will know more after a meeting to be held in March.

VITAL RECORDS: County Clerk Steven Toth says a new state law, Public Act No. 522, will go into effect in the county clerk's office on February 9, 1981.

The cost of certified copies and records and certification of registration have been boosted from \$3. to \$10. Additional copies of records ordered at the same time have increased from \$1. to \$3. An additional search of records over three years will cost \$3. and a verification of facts on any record will cost \$3. The price of correction or amendment of vital statistics has been increased from \$5. to \$20. Senior citizens may obtain vital records for \$2.

The rules for searching the records and copying information at the clerk's office are still the same. The hours are from 2 to 4 pm Monday thru' Friday.
